



PRINT AND PLAY INSTRUCTIONS

print and play folder includes:

- print and play instructions
- PDF document of the game manual
- a 12 page PDF document with backs and fronts of all needed cards, 3 cheat sheets and 1 turn tracker card
- PDF document with current player and turn tracker tokens

additional things needed for play:

- money tokens - 10 per player + 10 extra just in case
- space for table play

TIPS FOR MAKING CARDS

If you're printing cards at home, I recommend you print them on thicker paper and/or use card sleeves. This will make playing and shuffling much easier.

Cards are prepared in standard card size of 63x88mm (3.5"x2.5") and made to comfortably fit into sleeves for bridge, poker or MTG cards. You can get sleeves at most game stores or online for 3-12€ per 100 sleeves.

If using sleeves with opaque backs or saving ink, there's no need to print the back of cards - just make sure the front does not show through.

To print the card backs, figure out how to turn the paper with printed fronts so your printer won't print over them. Print files are symmetrical, so other orientation doesn't matter.

When cutting cards yourself, it's easiest to use a gillotine, but an exacto knife or scissors are ok too. The art for card fronts is the exact size to serve as cut guide and the art on card backs extends 2mm beyond this cut line in all sides to make up for printer inaccuracy.

TIPS FOR MONEY TOKENS

It's recommended tokens are small and easy to pick up. If you don't have boardgame tokens, you can use any small object you have multiples of - like beans, buttons, stones etc.
